### Week of Prayer for Baptist Associations

October 18<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> is the national Week of Prayer for Baptist Associations. What does it mean to pray for your Baptist association – the Columbia Metro Baptist Association? That all depends on what you consider to be the association.

Let's begin by considering the priority of CMBA which is listed above as *Starting and Strengthening Congregations to Serve as Vital and Vibrant Missional Communities*. As you let that priority sink in, you should realize that our association is churches-in-association with one another and not the organizational entity known as the Columbia Metro Baptist Association. Yes, we need the staff and structure of the association to function with effectiveness, but that is not our focus; congregations in fellowship on mission are our focus.
